

Unisa Library Services (all Branches) affected by ICT maintenance work on Saturday 31 July and 1 August 2010

Unisa Library wishes to inform all users planning to visit the Unisa libraries over the last weekend of July that only extremely restricted services will be available on **Saturday 31 July 2010** due to the scheduled **downtime of the Unisa systems** to allow for an upgrade of the network.

Likewise, clients wishing to use the Library's web site over the weekend of 31 July and 1 August 2010 will not be able to use the catalogue and subject databases.

The Library regrets that the following services will **not** be available:

- Removal of blocks or any financial enquiries
- Special Membership applications
- Database searches
- Electronic requesting of materials
- Library Catalogue searches to locate books on the shelf

The Library will be able to offer the following services to clients who visit the Library:

- Books can be accepted for return. Clients will receive a manual receipt and the books will be processed first thing on Monday 2 August 2010

- The Library Cashier can accept payments but will not be able to process them until Monday 2 August 2010
- Books will be issued manually
