

Accessing our Catalogue on your cell phone

You can access our OASIS library catalogue to search for books, request and renew library items on your own web-enabled phone through AirPAC, a product that will auto-detect the type of device you are using and format our catalogue screens accordingly without graphics for better viewing. AirPAC can also be accessed through a standard browser and will display faster for users of slow dial-up connections.

What you need to access AirPAC

- A web enabled cellphone (WAM) with 3G / HSDPA







After selecting **Request** from the bibliographic screen the AirPAC Login screen will open, where you will have to enter your surname, student / staff number and PIN.

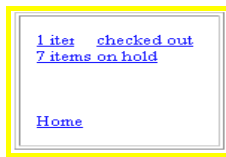

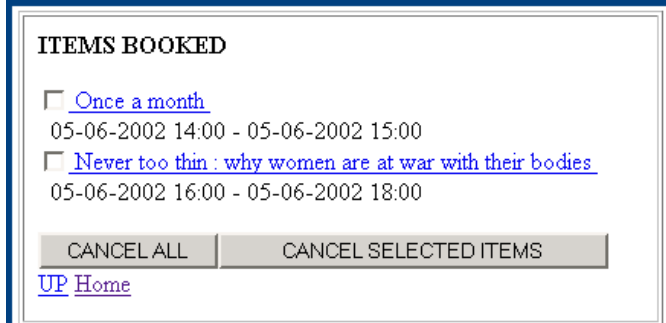


Select Items Checked Out to view 'n list of titles out on your name.

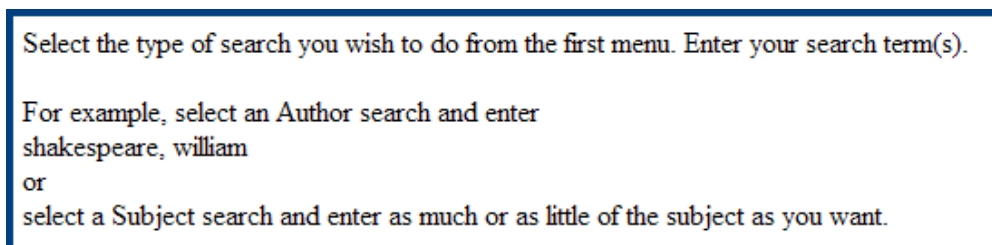


From here you can renew items out on your name.
