Multistorey building on Unisa's Sunnyside Campus to be demolished to make way for a new multipurpose centre

The old and dilapidated multistorey Building 30, located on Unisa's Sunnyside campus in Pretoria, is set to be demolished to make way for the development of new infrastructure on the campus, including the construction of the envisaged Sunnyside Multi-purpose Centre that will serve Unisa staff, students and the surrounding communities. The demolition by implosion will take place on Sunday, 05 May 2024.

The state of dilapidation of the old Building 30 is extreme and not structurally sound for renovations. Its existence in its current state has been raised as a concern by both the City Council of Tshwane and the university community.

Members of the media are invited to attend and witness the demolition by implosion. The details are as follows:

A designated viewing area has been earmarked strictly for people with access permits as the area will be under control of the contractor and authorised team in line with regulations for this nature of building demolitions.
