4. CERTIFICATES: SECOND SESSION 2014

We are unfortunately experiencing a significant delay in the issuing of the 2014 second session certificates. This is due to internal inter-departmental processes that have flowed from the accreditation of the music graded examinations as official Short Learning Programmes of the University. Teachers will be notified via SMS when the certificates are despatched via courier.

5. ONLINE REGISTRATION
