- Manage students' online learning experiences.
- Facilitate students' online interactions with their peers.

REQUIREMENTS:

To be considered as an E-tutor, you must meet the following requirements:

- Not be a Unisa Fixed Term or Permanent staff member.
- Ongoing access to Internet connection at your own cost.
- Only applicants with the relevant M. Ed/PhD degree in Education or equivalent Masters /Doctoral degree and/or teaching experience will be considered.
- Please do not apply if you are currently appointed as a Unisa e-tutor, marker or teaching assistant.
- Shortlisted candidates will have to undergo virtual or face-to-face interview and training.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Experience in teaching. (ODeL teaching experience will be an added advantage).
- Advanced computer and Internet skills i.e. no training will be provided in using software packages and Internet sites. e.g. Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook and MS Teams
- Advanced communication skills and proficiency in English (students communication will mostly be text based via myUnisa and discussion forums).
- Knowledge of the discipline applying for.
- Knowledge of e-learning theories and best practices for online teaching and learning.
- Understanding the diverse backgrounds and learning needs of students, especially in an open and distance e-learning environment.
- Clear, engaging and responsive communication skills for effective interaction with students online.
- Proficiency in digital tools for creating, sharing and evaluating online materials, and handling digital communication tools.
- Ability to build and provide support for students.
- Ability to manage time effectively, balancing the demands of online teaching with providing timely feedback and engaging in discussions.
- Capacity to create a supportive, inclusive and interactive online learning environment that fosters student engagement.
- Ability to address student challenges and solve issues related to module content.

- Ability to work under pressure with adherence to deadlines and a passion for student-centered learning.
- Friendly, patient and sensitive to diverse student population.

- Not be regarded as an employee of Unisa.
