The University of South Africa (UNISA) in collaboration with the Afrikan Peer Growth Network (APGroN) is to hold three days, 4th international conference on the 18 - 20 September 2024, at Unisa Parow Regional Campus in Cape Town, under the theme “**Advancements in International Law: Navigating the frontiers of aviation, aerospace, maritime studies, and the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR)**”

Building on the successes of the previous conferences that took place in 2021 (Cape Town), 2022 and 2023 in Pretoria, this gathering of judicial giants aims to delve into the niche areas of international law, with a specific focus on aviation and aerospace, maritime studies, and the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR).

The conference is framed around the core catalytic niche areas that underpin the developmental agenda of Unisa, together with the United Nation’s 17 Sustainable Development Goals. Key amongst these catalytic niche areas are student support, 4IR, marine studies, aviation and aerospace studies and feminist, womanist, bosadi theorizations.
