Unisa to confer honorary doctorates on Chief Justice Raymond Zondo and Deputy Chief Justice Mandisa Maya

The top two judges of the Republic of South Africa, Chief Justice Raymond Zondo and Deputy Chief Justice Mandisa Maya will be conferred with honorary doctorates by the University of South Africa (Unisa) at separate graduation ceremonies to be held at the Unisa Muckleneuck Campus, Pretoria, this week.

This follows a decision of the Unisa Council on 29 June 2023, which resolved to award the degrees of Doctor of Laws (LLD) (*Honoris Causa*) to the two judges of the Constitutional Court in recognition of their sterling contribution to the legal profession in South Africa.

Chief Justice Raymond Zondo

For Chief Justice Zondo, the honorary doctorate will be conferred in recognition of the following:

- Demonstrated ethical leadership of the South African judiciary over decades of selfless service.
- Commitment to defending and maintaining the independence of the judiciary as an important arm of the state.
- Upholding the ethos and aspirations of a democratic South Africa as enshrined in the Constitution.
- Maintaining the rule of law and ensuring that justice is accessible to all members of society regardless of whatever standing.
- Mentoring and promotion of legal professionals, and according recognition to those with exceptional skills and qualifications.
- Commitment to ensuring equitable representation of the judiciary to reflect the country's national diversity.

- Maintenance of high standards in the development of jurisprudence excellence.
- Empowering and mentoring women in the judiciary and the broader legal profession.
- Ethical leadership and exceptional administrative skills exemplified by high ethical and moral standards.
- Consistent excellence of selfless human service throughout her legal professional life.
