UNISA TO CONFER HONORARY DOCTORATE ON WINNIE MADIKIZELA-MANDELA

The University of South Africa (Unisa) will confer the degree of Doctor of Social Work (*honoris causa*), posthumously, on one of South Africa's foremost struggle stalwarts, crusaders for social justice and anti-Apartheid activists, the late Mrs Winnie Madikizela-Mandela, at a graduation ceremony to be held at the Unisa Main Campus in Pretoria on Tuesday, 29 October 2019.

The honorary degree will be conferred on the late Mrs Madikizela-Mandela in recognition of her revolutionary social work which impacted on individuals, groups and communities, her radical challenge to the Apartheid system from the early stages of her life as a professional social worker as well as the role she played in bringing social change as an activist and a community developer to empower women.

Mr Zondwa Mandela, representing the Madikizela-Mandela family, will receive the honorary degree as well as deliver the acceptance message on behalf of the family.
