

## **UNISA 2019 AUTUMN GRADUATIONS**

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 29 March 2019

The University of South Africa (Unisa) is not only the largest university in Africa but it produces the highest number of graduates in the country. For the 2019 autumn graduations, the number of qualifications has increased to more than 30 000, which makes Unisa an epicentre of knowledge production through teaching, learning, research and innovation.

Provisionally included in this figure are 109 doctorates, 190 master's, and 1 278 honours degrees. Graduates with both three- and four-year bachelor's degrees numbered 9 566, while there were 16 389 undergraduate diplomas and certificates.

Among our colleges, the College of Education produced the most qualifications at 16 302, while Gauteng Region headed the overall list with 7 023 degrees.

In total, 30 690 students will receive qualifications during Unisa's current graduations that began on 4 March and will finish on 28 June 2019.

Unisa Graduation ceremonies will also to be held in Pretoria, Mbombela, Polokwane, Cape Town, Durban, Nelspruit, East London, and Bloemfontein.
