The University of South Africa (Unisa) has learnt with regret that there are scores of prospective students who have descended on some of the regional service centres today (Wednesday, 03 April 2019) to apply for admission to the second semester of 2019.

We have also established that the prospective students are responding to a false message distributed by an unknown source about Unisa's application process for this period. This statement was neither issued nor sanctioned by Unisa; and the university therefore distances itself from it.
