The Suit is a story of love, commitment, and Sophiatown swag all wrapped in the fabric of apartheid imposed poverty. The story, set in Sophiatown speaks to ways in which narratives of remembering and survival are carved. The play further engages the perpetual struggles of living under a system that relegated some people in the zone of non-being. Some of the broad issues to be reflected upon, include, but are not limited to: A Sophiatown that provokes questions around the physiological and psychological wellbeing of a community under the abuses of Apartheid; marriage, infidelity and the notion of masculinity and femininity; and dreams deferred (yearning for what was lost/given up/taken away).
