WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE COHORT ONE GRADUATION CEREMONY 21 September 2022, University of South Africa, Pretoria

Thirty-five participants of the Water Sanitation and Hygiene programme will graduate on September 21<sup>st</sup> joining the Regional Leadership Center's alumni community of over 6 500 young leaders across Southern Africa.

Their graduation brings to a close a ten-and-a-half-weeks' programme which started with the eightweek virtual, blended learning programme that focused on orientation, contextual, and business development aspects of the WASH sector. Following the virtual programme, the participants continued their learning through a two-and-a-half-weeks' in-residence programme that exposed them to engaging conversations, networking opportunities, sharing ideas and innovation. During the residency, participants had an opportunity to pitch their innovative solutions for the water sector to the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). They also visited Rand Water in Zuikerbosch, the Daspoort Waste Water Treatment Plant in Pretoria and other businesses to learn about good practice in water resource management, purification, and innovation.

The participants will be honoured at a graduation ceremony hosted by the YALI Regional Leadership Center Southern Africa (YALI RLC-SA) and the University of South Africa (Unisa).
