CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF EXTERNAL MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE INSTITUTIONAL FORUM

The University of South Africa calls for the nominations of two external members to serve on the Institutional Forum (IF) in accordance with paragraph 36(1)(j) of the Institutional Statute. The IF is established in terms of section 26(2)(f), read with section 31 of the Higher Education Act (HEA) 101 of 1997, as amended, to advise Council on a wide range of issues affecting the University, including:

- The implementation of the Higher Education Act and the national policy on higher education.
- Race and gender equity issues
- Selection of candidates for senior management positions.
- Codes of conduct, mediation and dispute resolution procedures.
- Fostering an institutional culture that promotes tolerance and respect for fundamental human rights.
- Fostering an institutional culture that creates appropriate research and teaching and learning environment.
- Other functions that may be delegated or assigned to it by Council.

Nominees must have a minimum of a three-year qualification from a recognised institution with a demonstrable track record in one or more of the following fields: law, corporate governance, higher education policy, social justice (including championing against gender-based violence), transformation and gender equity.

Nominations must be in writing and must be accompanied by the nominee's curriculum vitae together with certified ID and qualification copies. The nominee must indicate in writing his/her acceptance of the nomination and willingness to serve on the Institutional Forum if he/she is appointed.
