Unisa to host memorial service in honour of the late Professor Muxe Nkondo

The University of South Africa (Unisa) will host a memorial service in honour of the late Professor Muxe Nkondo at its main campus in Pretoria today (Wednesday, 21 August 2024).

Nkondo, an accomplished academic, scholar and public policy guru who served South Africa and the higher education sector with dedication and distinction for decades, passed away on Sunday, 18 August 2024.

He served on the Council of Unisa for eight years, including as Chairperson of the Academic and Student Affairs Committee of Council (ASACoC), Acting Chairperson of the Social and Ethics Committee of Council (SECoC) and a member of Senate.

The memorial service will be attended by leaders of government and political parties, academics, public servants and activists, with tributes by, amongst others, the Honourable Minister of International Relations and Cooperation, Mr Ronald Lamola, the Honourable Deputy Minister of Higher Education, Mr Buti Manamela as well as the Former Minister of Tourism, Ms Lindiwe Sisulu.
