Dr. Morakinyo Akintolu is a Senior Postdoctoral Research Fellow with the UNESCO Chair on Open Distance Learning at the University of South Africa. Under the mentorship of Prof. Moeketsi Letseka since 2021, his work focuses on Open Distance eLearning, Adult Education, ICT in Education, and youth development. With over a decade of experience in social impact and higher education, he has published 20+ research articles, co-authored two books, and is currently developing a research book on adult education in Africa. Passionate about ethical leadership, he strives to drive innovation and development in diverse communities.



Dr. Ariné Kuyler is a Postdoctoral Fellow in the Department of Inclusive Education. Her research centers on the communication and participation of persons with disabilities, focusing on augmentative and alternative communication in education, healthcare, and palliative care, as well as digital health tools. She collaborates with researchers from South Africa, Sweden, India, and Colombia, and is part of the UGood PicPecc4well-being project. Supported by an NRF Postdoctoral Fellowship, Dr. Kuyler has published nine articles in ISI-accredited journals, with four more under review. She also serves on the board of Bliss Symbolics International and is a member of HPCSA, SASLHA, and SACE.
