- Research and innovations directly aligned with the theme "Relevant African Innovation", offering a distinctive focus on the societal impact of your research.
- Prospective postgraduate student participants have not previously taken part in the Annual UNISA Research
 & Innovation Postgraduate Student Showcase under their current registered qualification
- UNISA staff studying through UNISA are not allowed to participate.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All submissions should be in Arial, 11pt and 1.5-spaced.
- Name and surname
- Student number
- The project title should be included in the abstract. (Note that the title cannot be changed after submitting.)
- Registered qualification and discipline (as indicated in Table 1). Do not submit encrypted documents that will need passwords.
- Articulate research objectives, methodology, key findings, and Impact and implications of the project (Candidates who have not collected data are ineligible).
