


Academic Integrity Course – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Question	Answer
1. Who must complete the Academic Integrity Course?	The course is compulsory for all students registered in NQF Level 5–8 programmes . Master’s and PhD students are exempt from completing this course but should discuss academic integrity expectations with their supervisors.
2. I can’t find the course on myModules. Where is it?	The course is hosted on the UNISA MOOC site , not myModules. Please go to https://mooc.unisa.ac.za and log in with your student credentials.
3. I visited the Mooc Site but don’t see my course	You will only see the course on the weeks in which you are allocated to. Please go to https://myadmin.unisa.ac.za/student/portal/aic/check to check your allocated group sites and corresponding due dates
4. I completed the FYE1500 course, do I still need to complete the Academic Integrity Course	Yes, the Academic Integrity Course is compulsory for all students registered in NQF Level 5–8 programmes .
5. Are there consequences for not completing the course?	Yes. Section 17.5 of the Unisa 2025 Student rules outlines: Students who do not complete the course within the specified timeframe may face academic consequences, potentially including restrictions on academic progression or registration for subsequent modules.
6. What happens if I	Students who do not complete the course by the due date will receive a formal warning letter , which will be stored in their academic file

7. Will I get a certificate after completing the course?	Yes. Completion emails are issued at the end of the semester . In the meantime, ensure your course progress shows 100% and that you have received the badge on the platform.
8. I can't move to the next section. What should I do?	<p>Ensure you have:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) completed all activities in the Study Unit; 2) clicked "Complete" on the last page of each SU; and 3) Achieve at least 80% pass in all assessments. If your pass mark is below this, you may need to retake the assessment to meet the completion requirement. <p>All circles on the left panel must be green, like Unit 1 below</p> <p>In your side menu you should see a green circle on the left of each unit, exam</p> 
9. I am stuck at SU 5 how do I proceed to SU6	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go back to each unit and ensure you have completed all the required activities. 2. Manually click "Complete" at the end of each unit where you may have forgotten to do so. 3. Check your assessment scores and retake anywhere you did not achieve at least 80%
10. I can't access SU6. What must I do?	Go to the last page of SU5 and click the " Complete " button. This will unlock SU6.
