

The Advocacy and Resource Centre for Students with Disabilities (ARCSWiD) invites students with disabilities to participate in the nomination process of the forums for students with disabilities. The nomination process will be opened from 04 -11 September 2024.

## Who is eligible to nominate?

Any student with a disability registered for a formal undergraduate, including a higher certificate or postgraduate qualification in any of UNISA's colleges.

## Who is eligible to be nominated?

- A student with a disability who is currently registered and has been registered for a formal undergraduate or postgraduate qualification in any of UNISA's colleges.
- As an undergraduate student, he/she has passed a minimum of ten modules towards a diploma or degree for which he/she has enrolled at the time of his/her nomination.
- Has completed a higher certificate qualification and is currently enrolled for a degree/diploma.
- He/she has not been found guilty by the duly authorised body of the university of violation of the student code of conduct or any other rules and regulations of the university.
- He/she has declared his/her disability and submitted proof of disability.
- Demonstrated interest in advocacy, leadership, or involvement in disability-related issues.

## Who qualifies to contest elections?

For each nominee to be considered, they must obtain at least five nominations from registered students with disabilities in that region. However, five nominations do not guarantee a nomination. To improve the chances of succeeding during the nomination and voting process, each nominee is strongly encouraged to get more than five nominations.

MS Teams will be created per region to allow students to network amongst themselves, and communication will be sent via myLife email accounts. The nomination process and regional platforms will be opened from 4-11 September 2024.
