#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The showcase is open to all 2022 Unisa registered honours, postgraduate diploma, master's and doctoral students from all disciplines excluding academic staff members.




#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- Students wishing to participate in this programme must submit the following:
  - a. The submission/application form
  - b. The abstract (only one abstract per applicant)
    - 1. The abstract should not be more than one page and should include the following:
    - 2. Background, purpose, and objective
    - 3. Methodology
    - 4. Results and their significance
    - 5. Conclusion and recommendation

#### c. Proof of registration

- Please note that abstracts that exceed one (1) page will be rejected without further consideration.
- Abstracts will be evaluated by discipline specific technical committee, based on the following criteria:



 The students with the best abstracts from each discipline will be invited for training on how to prepare an abstract and oral presentation.

#### **PRIZES**

- The winners and runners-up will receive certificates.
- The cash prizes per category in each discipline are listed below:

- The winners in each category may form part of a Unisa student delegation to go on an international visit to another institution provided they have not participated in the programme before.
- The winners in each discipline will be announced during the award ceremony to be held on 2 August 2022.

#### What should the student submit?

- An abstract not more than 1 page (All submissions should be in Arial, 12p and 1.5 spaced). The student number, discipline and project title should be included the abstract.
- 2. Proof of 2022 registration
- 3. The submission/application form





#### NOTES ON THE PREPARATION OF SUBMISSIONS

- 1. Students are advised to take note of the University's *Policy on Academic Integrity*.
- 2. No student will be allowed to have his or her name on the programme more than two times, as an author or co-author, on any kind of presentation.
- 3. Students who won in the previous years are not allowed participate within three years/for the same qualification
- 4. Presentations of postgraduate (honours, postgraduate diploma, master's and doctoral) will be allocated a total time of 20 minutes - of which 15 minutes will be for the actual presentation and 5 minutes for questions and comments.
