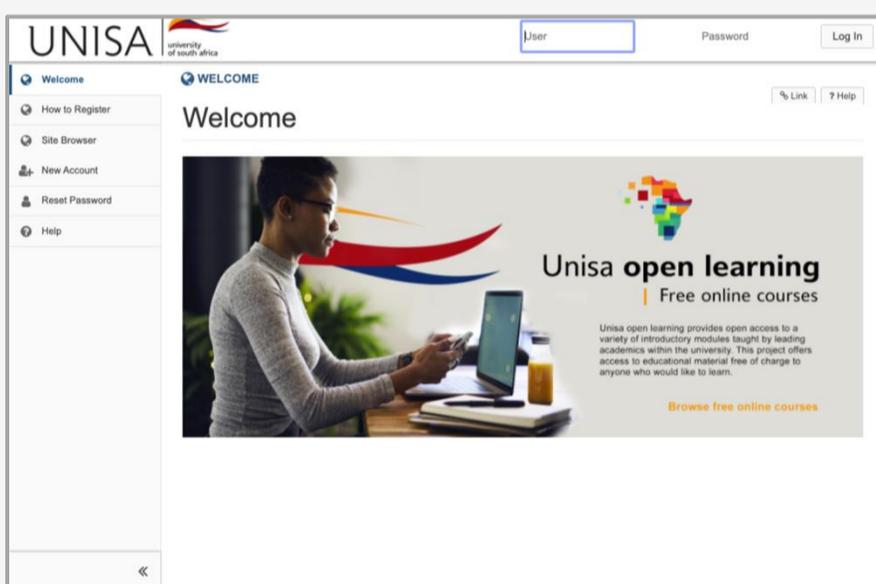
By completing the OER, you will learn about the following:



### Getting Started:

Step 01: Open the Unisa Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) site

Go onto the UNISA MOOC Portal using the following URL: <https://mooc.unisa.ac.za/portal>



Step 02: Create your account

You will have to create your own account as the Unisa MOOC site is not linked to myUnisa.

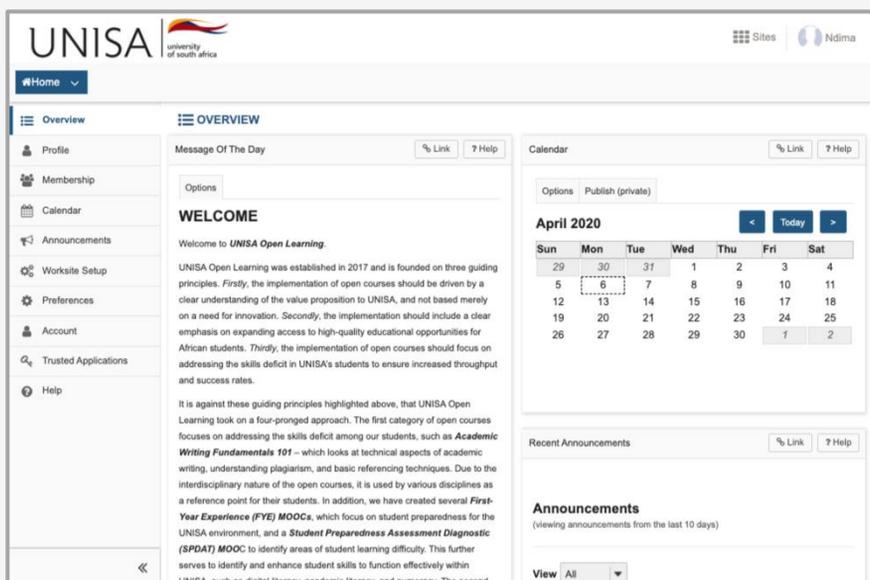
Complete the following steps to create an account:

1. Click on **New Account** in the left menu on the landing page.
2. Complete your MOOC account details by creating your own **User ID** and **Password**. Complete all the required fields. Remember to keep your new User ID and Password safe, as you will be required to use the same login details for all future logins.
3. Click on **Create Account**

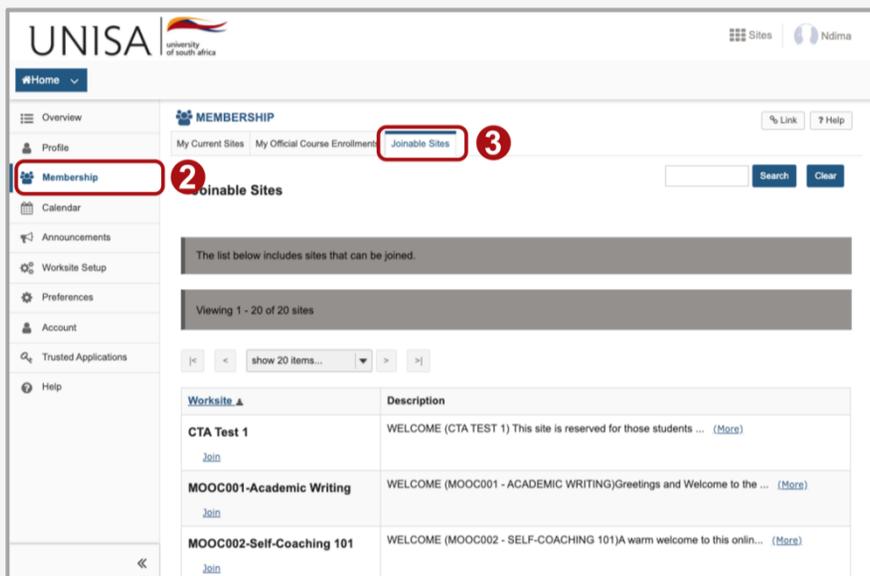
Step 03: Enrol for the OER006 – Digital Literacy course

All the courses on the Unisa MOOC site are free to join. Complete the following steps to enrol for the OER006 – Digital Literacy.

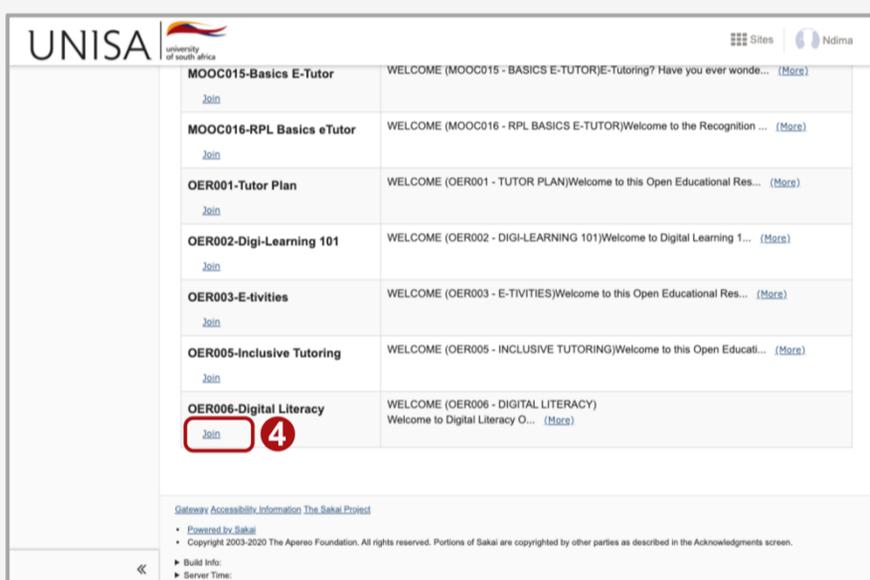
1. Sign in to the Unisa MOOC site with your new User ID and Password.



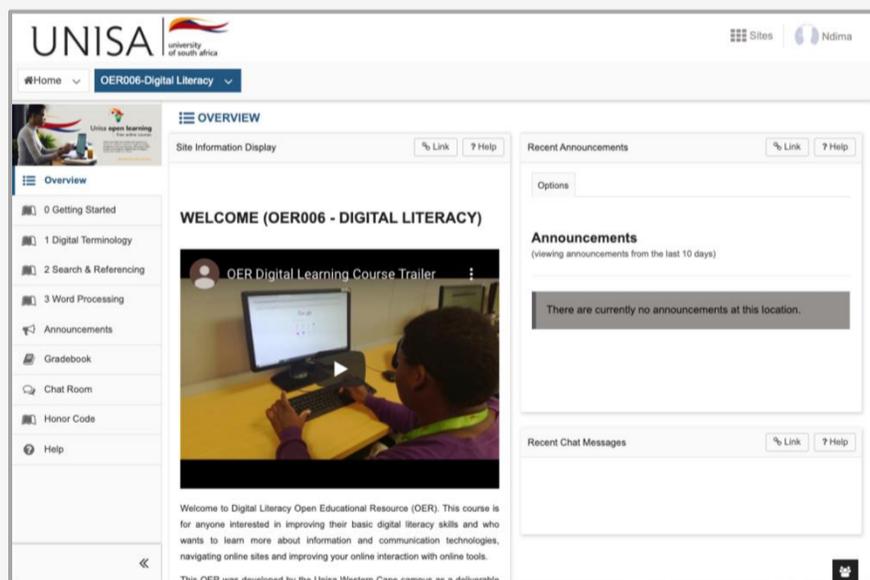
2. On the left menu click on **Membership**
