

Online Registration Guideline

The online registration platform is accessible on most devices that have a browser. It would be best to use a device with a larger screen for optimal viewing. The online registrations can however be done on a smaller screen such as a smart phone.

NB: Before you proceed with submitting your registration, please read the rules for your qualification and take note of any changes.

The online form requires you to

- a) complete the modules and period for which for wish to register for 2022. Correct any errors shown in red when completing the form,
- b) look at the contact details that we have on our records for you and you must amend any address or phone numbers if necessary,
- c) Accept the terms and conditions,
- d) Make an online payment or note the other payment options that will be on an email once you submit the registration.

Note the following important rules:

1. You cannot register for more than 5 modules (60 credits) per semester
2. You cannot register for more than 10 modules (120 credits) for an academic year.
3. You cannot register for modules for which you have not passed the pre- requisites.

Some common errors that you may encounter and how to correct these

You will have to remove the module code(s) causing the pre-requisite error from the list of modules selected (click in the Remove box next to the module and then click on <Remove the selected study unit>) or include the co-requisite modules as part of your selection. After removing the module(s), click on <NEXT> to continue with your application for registration.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>1.2 Click on the <Submit to Admissions & Registrations> button to submit your registration application to the registration section. If you submit your application in this manner, it means that your registration submission will need to be processed manually in the order of the date on which it was submitted. This may take a few weeks to be processed.</p>

If you submit your application in this manner, it means that your registration submission will need to be processed manually in the order of the date on which it was submitted.
