With unprecedented fervour, you articulated various efforts that gave life to the Catalytic Niche Areas that were strategically introduced to stimulate growth in research and innovation, engaged scholarship and our internationalization drive. Indeed, the numbers do not lie. Our Research Publication Units stand at 1 323 2237, the sum of your commitment to research.

In what is clearly a labour of love on your part, you admirably actualised our commitment to improving our research outputs and their impact—by increasing per capita from 1.6 to 2.0 overall per permanent staff member and research citation index to reach 1 basis points above the national SA index yearly. This we have achieved, with a corresponding rise in NRF rated researchers in the higher categories. Management and I are very proud of your pursuit of research-led teaching and teaching-led research that are manifesting in the improved throughput rate that hovers at around 78%.
