IRIS Invigilation (IRIS) is a software program that helps provide UNISA staff with assurance of assessment integrity during the online and remote assessments.

IRIS records audio, video, and computer screen activity for the duration of a test/exam. It analyses this information using machine learning and automatically flags potential academic dishonesty.

NOTE: IRIS IS ONLY USED FOR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY (CSET). IF YOUR COURSE DOES NOT FALL PART OF CSET, YOU WILL NOT BE USING IRIS INVIGILATION.
