

Preparing for assignments

As you prepare for your assignments, we recommend that you make notes as it will help you to make sense of your module content. The best way to prepare for assignments is to create a study plan for the semester. By now you should know exactly the number of assignments you need to complete for this semester and their due dates and roughly how much time you want to dedicate to each assignment.

Planning well in advance means you should have more time to prepare for each assignment and will help you avoid working under pressure. It is important that you submit your assignments early to avoid the risk of system crash and system overload.

You are kindly advised to register on myUnisa so that you can be able to download your study material immediately after your registration has been processed. You do not need to wait for your material to be posted as it might delay and affect your assignment due dates.

The importance of assignments

Assignments are a form of evaluating the students understanding of the content that they are engaging with. They also help students to prepare for examinations and contribute towards your year mark.

Where to find assignment questions?

For online modules you will not receive any printed study material as your module is strictly done online. Assignment questions and instructions are available on the module site on myUnisa. Therefore, students are expected to submit their assignments online.

For modules that are not online, students are expected to consult tutorial letter 101 to check assignment unique numbers and due dates.
