- Must be a South African citizen
- Applicants must be enrolled in a full-time one-year honours degree program.
- The combined household income of the applicant must not exceed R700,000 per annum.
- Applicants must be studying at one of South Africa's 26 public universities.
 Students from Historically Disadvantaged Institutions (HDIs) will be given first preference
- A minimum of 60% in matric mathematics is required. Please note, Mathematical Literacy does not qualify.
- Applicants must be between the ages of 21 and 35. Students turning 36 or older in 2026 are not eligible.
- Applicants must have completed their undergraduate degree between 2023 and 2025.
- Only students pursuing their first postgraduate qualification are eligible.
- An overall average of 60% or higher in the undergraduate degree is required for consideration.
