ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

In 2020 the B-BBEE Commission released a report on the National Status and Trends on broad-based economic empowerment (B-BBEE) for the calendar year 2019. According to the report, for real and accelerated broad-based black economic empowerment to be achieved, the mandatory components of the B-BBEE Act must be applied consistently by both the private and public sectors. In line with the concerns identified in the report, during the period 2017 - 2019, the programme addresses the need for the development of an efficient transformation management tool to meet the changing trends and industry challenges of the country to increase and stimulate the pace of transformation in the economy.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The programme is aimed at current and future transformation leaders as well as business owners. Participants in the B-BBEE EDP must be in possession of a postgraduate NQF Level 7 qualification.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

The programme will capacitate delegates with advanced skills and knowledge in the areas of corporate governance, ownership, management control, skills development and enterprise and supplier development. Participant will also acquire the necessary socio economic development skills to effectively implement B-BBEE as responsible corporate citizens.
