ADMISSION

In order to participate in PASM you need to have successfully completed either the UNISA Centre for Business Management Course in Strategic Management, or equivalent and with 5 years' management experience; or 5 years' experience in Strategic Management.

ON COMPLETION

After completing this 1 year programme, leaders in the public and private sector will be equipped with the skills and abilities to successfully apply strategic principles and practices in the organisation.

ASSESSMENT

Formative assessments (assignments) will be required per module together with a portfolio assessment.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS

This programme will equip you to understand and apply strategic management principles, processes and plans in order to enhance and advance their organisational strategic goals and performance requirements.

REGISTRATION

The application and registration process for the PASM takes place from September 2018 until January 2019. Attendance at the PASM study school is compulsory and the dates thereof will be provided. Please note the Application Fee for 2019 is R160 and is in addition to the tuition fees.
