If you are a senior manager in the public and private sector with a minimum of Matric or equivalent, plus an NQF level 8 qualification with at least 10 years' managerial experience. Alternatively a portfolio of evidence of prior learning will be considered based on Unisa's policy requirements for short learning programmes.

- ◆ measure the innovation orientation of their organisations and develop programmes for creating a culture of innovation in their organisations; and
