MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The Management Development Programme (MDP) aims to equip middle managers with the means to become effective managers, pursuing the goals of excellence within their own organisations. The programme is designed to facilitate an understanding of, and the ability to integrate and apply the key competencies required for each of the functional areas of business.

ADMISSION

Applicants must have a Senior Certificate and at least three years' managerial experience.

ON COMPLETION

After completing this one year programme, middle managers in the public and private sector with a minimum of three years' managerial experience, should be able to apply the knowledge and skills in various key areas of business management in the organisation.

ASSESSMENT

Formative assessment (assignments)

In each of the modules, two syndicate group assignments must be completed

Summative assessment (examinations)

An open-book exam will be conducted.
