

7 MANAGING management

FUNDAMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (FMP)

This FMP aims to equip entry-level managers with theoretical knowledge and hands-on skills that enable them to handle fundamental management aspects and to be team leaders in rapidly changing organisations. First-level managers such as supervisors and superintendents, as well as small business managers, enrol in the FMP to gain management background necessary for development and promotion. The FMP is offered for both the business as well as public sector stream. Some students also use the FMP as a bridging education before embarking on more advanced management development programmes.

Fundamental Management Programme



ADMISSION

Applicants must have a Senior Certificate and at least three years' experience.

ON COMPLETION

After completing this one year programme, entrylevel managers in the public and private sector with a minimum of three years' work experience, should be able to apply basic management principles in the organisation. The FMP is offered in two streams for participants namely business and public.

ASSESSMENT

- 1. Formative assessment (assignments). In each module, two syndicate group assignments are submitted for evaluation. These count towards a year mark.
- 2. Summative assessment (examinations). An open-book exam will be written.

The application and registration process for the FMP takes place from September 2018 until January 2019. Attendance at the FMP study school is compulsory and the dates of these events will be provided. Please note the Application Fee for 2019 is R160 and is in addition to the tuition fees.
