ADMISSION

Applicants must have a Senior Certificate and at least three years' managerial experience. Admission is granted on the understanding that students are able to attend weekly syndicate group meetings at the SBL in Midrand.

ON COMPLETION

After completing this one year programme, project managers in the public and private sector with a minimum of three years' managerial experience, should be able to effectively execute projects in the organisation.

ASSESSMENT

1. In each of the modules, two syndicate group assignments must be completed. These assignments count towards a year mark.
2. Summative assessment (examinations). An open-book exam will be written.
