

2017 PRACTICAL PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME

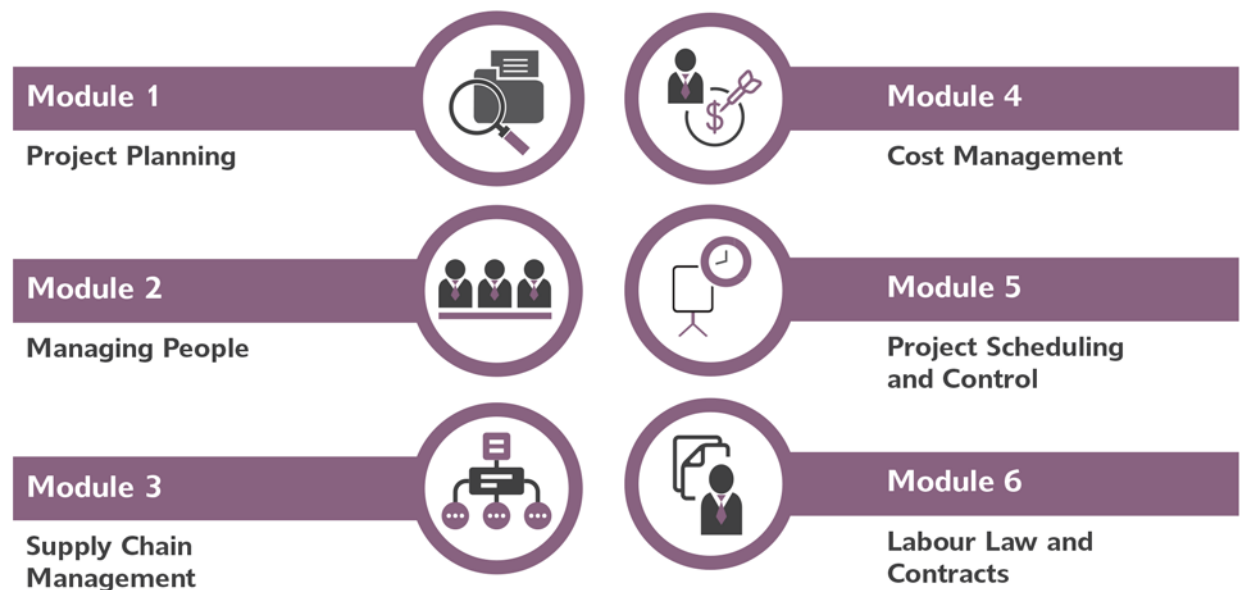
